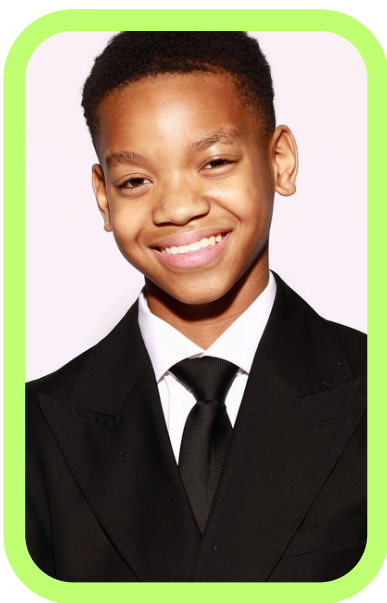

T-Strike, born Wallace McTear Jr., is a nationally recognized musical artist known for his powerful storytelling, passionate delivery, and unwavering authenticity. With a deep love for God, people, and music, he began creating music at just 11 years old—and hasn't stopped since. As a husband, father, and entrepreneur, T-Strike has traveled the country and beyond, using his platform to inspire and impact lives through faith-filled lyrics. A respected voice in the world of Christian rap, he has graced some of the biggest stages alongside both Christian and mainstream artists, consistently delivering music that reflects his heart, his journey, and his mission.

When the Lord has a calling on your life, the journey begins in alignment with His Word and in His perfect timing.

Brother Elijah Carswell was born on January 9, 2002, in Atlanta, Georgia. He began his early education at Southwest Atlanta Christian Academy, where a foundation of faith in God was established. This spiritual grounding was also cultivated at his home church, Greater Community Church of God in Christ (COGIC). Being born there under Bishop Chandler Owens and continuing to serve under the new pastor Matthew Brown. More importantly, within his home where he was taught faith witnessing the results of having faith while being raised in the fear and admonition of the Lord. During these formative years, Elijah received the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues while serving as a youth usher at the COGIC National AIM Convention. He was also a featured National Purity speaker in Baltimore, Maryland.



He began independently studying and researching the Bible at a young age, which contributed to his spiritual maturity and leadership. During high school he was known for boldly witnessing for Christ and always being ready having an answer for the reason of the hope that is in him. He was chosen to represent the school at President Jimmy Carter Center's Annual Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday Forum on Conflict Resolution and Bridging the Divide. His academic and extracurricular achievements along with awards during high school were numerous.

Although his college journey began amid the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, Elijah sought the Lord through fasting and praying and received confirmation from the Lord to attend Samford University, where he was awarded scholarships. He completed his undergraduate studies in just two years, earning a Bachelor of Science degree. He then went on the next semester to begin his professional education at Samford University's McWhorter School of Pharmacy, where he is pursuing and will receive his Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) with a concentration in Research, May 2026. During his time at Samford, Elijah served as a Senator for the School of Pharmacy.

Elijah gives all of the glory, honor and praise to God for all of the following accomplishments. He founded the *Samford Food Heroes Program*, an initiative aimed at combating food insecurity both on campus and in the community. This program established a formal partnership between Samford University and the Grace Klein Community. The program was adopted by the university as one of its official programs. Elijah is recognized as the Founder of the initiative. For his impactful work, he was honored with one of the university's top three awards, recognized by the university as being prestigious the **Rufus Shelton Community Service Award**. He was **Samford's School of Pharmacy nomination** and was awarded the **United States Public Health Service (USPHS) Excellence in Public Health Pharmacy Award**. He was honored for his graduate student research presentation that evaluated the cancer healing properties of the South American "Butterfly Pea" herb. He has been a member of the Alpha Lambda Delta Honor Society that honors students with 4.0 GPA. He received the Student Executive Outstanding Commitment and Leadership Award for his exemplary leadership on Samford Gives Back Leadership Team.

Beyond his academic achievements, Elijah is wholly committed to serving the Lord through obedience to Scripture and the leading of the Holy Spirit. He has served as a **7-week Apologetics Instructor** under the leadership of Bishop Paul Q. Fortson, Paradise Church of God in Christ Layman School of Ministry equipping believers to defend the faith with biblically accurate responses to intellectual and spiritual challenges, in accordance with Jude 1:3.

He holds significant leadership roles in several ministries. He currently serves as the **Lead Intercessor** for an international evangelism prayer, and fasting ministry, where he leads weekly prayer sessions and provides sound Biblical teaching. He also serves as the Lead Intercessor for a local campus ministry, guiding fellow students through weekly virtual and on-campus prayer gatherings.

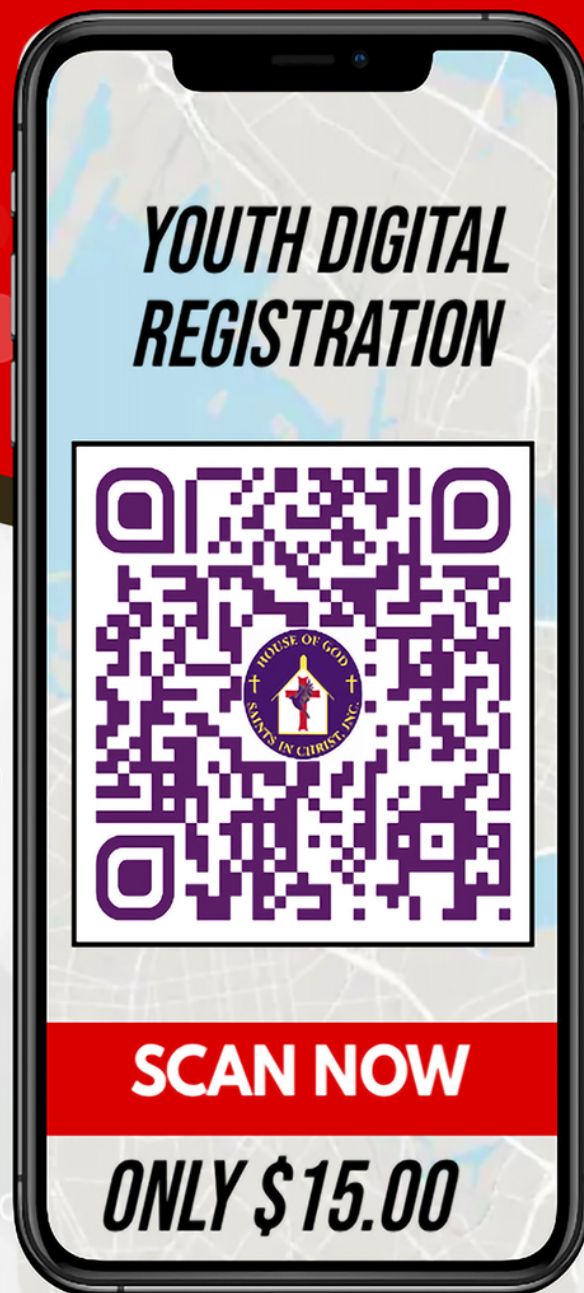
Elijah is also a **Chaplain** for the 2025 *Samford Gives Back* Leadership Team, where he provides weekly devotionals and prayer.

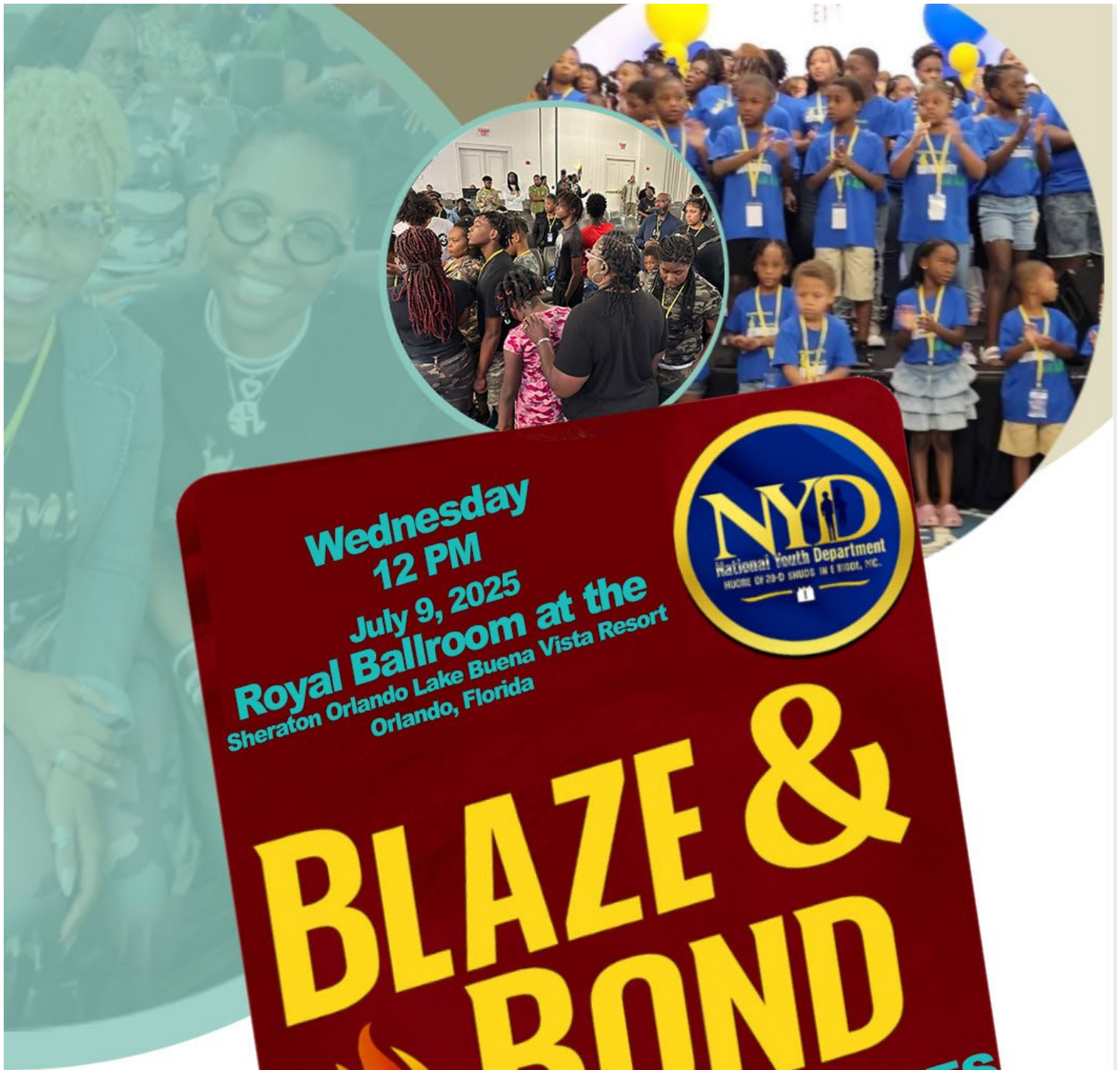
